



## Game Day Expectations at St. Simon

---

Please review the below information as it explains what your coaches, players, and spectators can expect when playing soccer or volleyball at St. Simon the Apostle this Fall Season.

### Prior to Arrival

- Per CYC guidelines - Coaches and officials will complete pre-screening questionnaire prior to arriving.
- Per CYC guidelines – All Players will have their parish's pre-screening questionnaire completed prior to arriving and confirmation provided to their Head Coach.
- Per CYC guidelines – Spectators are not required to complete questionnaire
- If anyone is feeling sick or experiencing symptoms they should not attend.

### Upon Arrival

- Please only park in the front parking lot. Our back-parking lot will only be available for handicapped /elderly parking
- We ask that coaches, players, spectators do not arrive more than 20 minutes prior to game time.
- Site worker will greet and provide direction to arriving coaches, players, and spectators.
  - Arriving teams will either be directed directly to one of the following places: field, gym, or one of the holding / waiting areas (1, 2, 3, o 4)
  - The above depends on whether the gym or field is vacated by prior teams

### Soccer Specific Details

- **Prior to game beginning site worker will ask the Head Coach from each team for verbal and / or visual confirmation that all players and coaches completed and passed pre-screening questionnaire.**
- Game balls **may** be provided
- One (1) Spectator per player will be allowed for games. Must comply by wearing masks and social distancing recommendations.
- Each team will be allowed 2 coaches on sideline
- Spectators will be allowed to watch from grass. Bleachers and pavilion are not to be used by spectators. Spectators must wear mask and use social distancing
- Our outside restrooms will be open and sanitized by our site workers throughout the day
- Pre-game prayer will be conducted, promote social distancing among all participants
- Post-game prayer will **NOT** be conducted to allow for quicker exit of field / return to car
- At the conclusion of the game: players, coaches and spectators will be asked to vacate the field and parking lot as quickly as possible. Masks must be worn until people are at their cars and promote social distancing.
- Game balls will be disinfected at half-time and in between games. If there is a stoppage of play, we will also disinfect the ball at this time.

### **Volleyball Specific Details**

- **Prior to game beginning site worker will ask the Head Coach from each team for verbal and / or visual confirmation that all players and coaches completed and passed pre-screening questionnaire.**
- Entering and Exiting the gym is outlined below:
  - Gym lobby doors will be ONLY used to enter the gym
  - Coaches, players, and spectators will exit the gym using doors between the gym and field
- Chairs will be provided for spectators. No outside seating (bag chairs) are to be used.
- Warm up balls will NOT be provided by St Simon. Visiting teams should provide own warm up balls.
- Warm up period will be for 10 minutes. Allowing each team 5 minutes on the court. (time between games may not allow for full warm-up)
- Game balls will be provided
- Entrance to the gym is only allowed for volleyball coaches, players, and spectators
- One (1) Spectator per player will be allowed for games. Must comply by wearing masks and social distancing recommendations.
- Each team will be allowed 2 coaches on sideline
- Spectators will be provided a chair to use in the gym. These chairs will be sanitized in between games. Spectators must wear mask and use social distancing
- Our inside restrooms will be open and sanitized by our site workers throughout the day
- Pre-game prayer will be conducted, promote social distancing among all participants
- Post-game prayer will **NOT** be conducted to allow for quicker exit of the gym / return to car
- At the conclusion of the game: players, coaches and spectators will be asked to vacate the field and parking lot as quickly as possible. Masks must be worn until people are at their cars and promote social distancing.
- Game balls will be rotated during the game as much as possible. Volleyballs will be disinfected in between games and in between matches.

### **Face Masks**

- Players must wear face coverings (not while playing, but when not active)
  - Face coverings should be placed in a clear plastic baggie with child's name on it when not wearing. Do Not place face covering on bench, grass or gym floor.
- Coaches **MUST** always wear face covering
- Referees **MUST** wear face coverings went entering the gym or field, they can be removed once activity begins
- Spectators **MUST** always wear face coverings

### **General Information**

- Concession Stand will NOT be open
- Water fountains have been covered / turned off
- Additional hand sanitizing stations have been added to our gym and soccer field
- No post-game prayer will be done. We would like coaches, players, and spectators to vacate the gym or field as quickly as possible and return to their vehicles
